Publisher's Introduction

This base comprises those individuals who actively provide educational services and include deans, heads, professors, scientists, lecturers, teachers and the administrative teams, including establishments which provide research and development facilities and who are responsible for the education at universities, colleges, junior colleges, secondary, elementary schools and pre-school nurseries. They are primarily engaged in teaching pupils of all ages and domains and are represented in this datacard in the general and specialist academic facilities.

Universities – the highest educational institutions with the authority to award degrees, traditionally in non-vocational subjects and representing bachelor and master degrees. Vocational courses may also be offered, leading to qualifications in professions such as medicine, engineering and law – see Work Area 82 SIC classifications.

Polytechnic Colleges – recently upgraded to university status, offering degree courses, principally in technical and vocational areas.

Junior Colleges, High Schools, Grammar Schools, Secondary Schools – provide mid-school scholarships leading to examinations that will qualify pupils to pass into universities and polytechnic colleges.

Elementary Schools, First Schools – provide education for pupils of any early age group with scholarships leading to junior colleges and high schools by qualified assessment or exam qualification.

Pre-School Nurseries – primarily a conditioning process for infant age groups to adjust to further education.

Libraries – selectable by academic faculties at universities or national, federal, local or state general libraries or corporate libraries.

Commercial, Economical, Sociological and Educational Research – available on a private fee paying basis, including business economics, market/commercial research, sociological research, archaeological expedition, medical and scientific research – see Work Area 92 for SIC classifications.

Educational Research Institutes – includes researchers and development executives, directors, chief officers conducting all forms of analytical science, research and development at university campus.

Selection Available – work place, work type, SIC classification, establishment size, gender income geographical by country & postcode, telephone, fax, email.

Source of Data – associations and institutes, journal publications, questionnaires, campaign response, strategic research, government registrations.
